Role Overview:

This internship can specialize in either worship music or worship tech. This person will participate in a structure that focuses on developing our worship services for both our online and in-person services. For worship music, this internship will focus on song choices, preparation for vocals and band, verbals, and execution in services. For worship tech, this internship can focus on a particular aspect of AVL as well as the overall preparation and execution of services. This internship also includes a focus on the development of strategies for working with volunteers that not only includes logistics but also focuses on a pastoral shepherding side of working with volunteers.

- Lead worship/tech on weekends as development progresses.
- Exercise creative work alongside our Senior Pastor and the entire team.
