Role Overview:

This internship offers practical experience while providing ministry support in all aspects of adult ministry at one of six Campuses. Projects could include strategic planning for the next ministry year, developing adult ministries special events and trainings or engaging with our congregation to promote our ministry opportunities. Be a part of working with volunteer ministry leaders, small group leaders and those within small groups at The Compass Church. This intern should be a team player who has a sense of organization and outreach.
