Our Membership process starts with:

- Step 1 Review the contents of the Membership Packet and identify questions. Read our Constitution included in this packet. We recognize that sometimes people have questions prior to completing the application. You can contact Kelly Arnquist at <u>membership@thecompass.net</u>.
- Step 2 Complete and return your Membership Application to the office. Mail or drop off your applications to either the Bolingbrook, Naperville, South Naperville or Wheaton Campus Offices. We will email you before the class as a reminder.
- Step 3 Attend a Membership Class/Interview.

Look for the upcoming dates in the Navigator or at <u>thecompass.net</u> by clicking on Menu in the top right hand corner and then on the "Membership" dropdown. Membership Classes are held on Sundays at various times. We offer classes at all four of our Campuses: Bolingbrook, Naperville, South Naperville and Wheaton. The first half of the class is an overview of The Compass Church's history, Membership covenant and doctrinal statement. After a time for questions, couples or individuals are teamed up with our Membership Coaches to review the Membership Application and answer any final questions. The applications are presented at the next Elder's meeting. The Membership prospects are shared with the congregation in our communication publication. When this process is complete, you will receive a Membership Certificate in the mail.

WHO QUALIFIES FOR MEMBERSHIP?

Membership in The Compass Church is open to anyone who professes faith in Jesus Christ as Savior, who is in agreement with the doctrinal statement of the Evangelical Free Church of America, and whose character and conduct are consistent with this profession. Children whose parents are members do not automatically become members, but must complete a separate application. Only those members 16 years of age or older have the right to vote at congregational meetings.
