Membership Classes are held typically on Sundays at various times and locations. We offer classes at all of our locations and online. The first half of the class is an overview of The Compass Church's history, Membership covenant and doctrinal statement. After a time for questions, couples or individuals are teamed up with our Membership Coaches to review the Membership Application and answer any final questions. The Membership prospects are shared with the congregation in our communication publication. The applications are presented at the next Elder's meeting. When this process is complete, you will receive a Membership Certificate in the mail.

### WHO QUALIFIES FOR MEMBERSHIP?

Membership in The Compass Church is open to anyone who professes faith in Jesus Christ as Savior, who is in agreement with the doctrinal statement of the Evangelical Free Church of America, and whose character and conduct are consistent with this profession. Children whose parents are members do not automatically become members, but must complete a separate application. Only those members 16 years of age or older have the right to vote at congregational meetings.
