# Deconstruction: A Doubter's Journey Week 1: Why Faith Falls Apart John 18-19 March 5, 2023 (Jeff Griffin, Senior Pastor)

Deconstruction is a journey of unpacking, rethinking, and examining our belief system. Wise, purposeful deconstruction can be healthy, but deconstruction without reconstruction can lead us down a dark path. In this series, we're learning how to wrestle with our questions and doubts in a way that yields growth instead of destruction.

## Kicking It Off:

If you had an unlimited budget, which room in your home would you love to remodel this year? And why?

### Discussion:

- 1. When you hear the term "deconstruction," what comes to mind for you? What are you hoping to gain from this sermon series about having spiritual doubts?
- 2. How did Jeff explain the differences between having a faith renovation, a restoration, or a complete demolition? In your opinion, what are some possible good things that might come from wrestling with big questions of faith?
- 3. Re-read Peter's situation in John 13:37-38. What are some ways in our current generation that we can potentially deny Christ as Lord?
  - "Peter asked, 'Lord, why can't I follow you now? I will lay down my life for you.' Then Jesus answered, 'Will you really lay down your life for me? Very truly I tell you, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times!"
- 4. Jeff outlined several causes for someone's faith to deconstruct. From this list, which one resonates with you the most? If you're comfortable, tell your group a little bit about your experience with it.

5. In light of Romans 14:13, what steps do you need to make this week so that you can live in peace with other believers around you?
