Position Summary

The Worship Pastor at The Compass Church is responsible for championing a healthy, vibrant worship culture and advancing the worship philosophy as directed by the Executive Pastor of Worship Arts and the Senior Pastor. In alignment with The Compass Church mission to *Find & Follow God*, this role provides spiritual leadership from the stage and helps create worship environments that invite people to encounter Christ, take next steps of faith, and grow as disciples.

The Worship Pastor leads the local congregation in engaging, Christ-centered worship experiences during weekend services and special events and serves as a key spiritual influencer within the Wheaton Campus. As a collaborative member of the Arts Team, the Worship Pastor works closely with central and campus partners to craft worship experiences that support campus health, growth, and outreach. This role carries meaningful influence on worship attendance and the capacity of the Wheaton Campus to effectively serve its community.

Primary Responsibilities

Spiritual Leadership & Culture

- Live a healthy, balanced lifestyle that honors God, family, and others.
- Demonstrate a stable, mature, vibrant, and growing relationship with Jesus Christ, evidenced by the fruits of the Spirit.
- Actively live out and model The Compass Church mission to *Find & Follow God* in both personal life and ministry leadership.
- Enthusiastically support and advance The Compass Church mission, vision, and strategic priorities.
- Affirm and model the Worship Arts Team vision, values, and Central Model.
- Remain culturally relevant in order to effectively connect with both churched and unchurched individuals.

Worship Leadership & Musical Excellence

- Serve as the primary worship leader for all weekend services at the Wheaton Campus.
- Lead worship with excellence through clear communication, spiritual sensitivity, strong musical leadership, and effective public speaking, including brief devotional moments or Scripture-based reflections during services.
- Demonstrate musical aptitude as a skilled instrumentalist and vocalist, including the ability to sing and/or play on pitch, maintain rhythm and timing, read music, harmonize, and improvise as needed.
- Collaborate with the Central Music Team to plan musical elements for weekend services and special events.

- Rehearse bands and vocalists in preparation for worship services.
- Hold auditions and provide constructive evaluation and feedback to vocalists and musicians.
- Serve as the primary worship leader for all weekend services at the Wheaton Campus.
- Lead worship with excellence through clear communication, spiritual sensitivity, and strong musical leadership.

- Provide Spirit-led and strategically focused leadership to Wheaton Campus Worship Arts volunteers in alignment with the broader church vision and values.
- Foster strong teamwork and communication among worship and production teams, upholding The Compass Church standards.

Planning, Collaboration & Administration

- Contribute to the planning and execution of weekend services and special events through collaboration with the Arts Team and other Campus ministries.
- Attend weekly brainstorming, planning, and production meetings relevant to worship services and events.
- Schedule volunteers and contractors for weekend services using Planning Center.
- Communicate clearly and in a timely manner with ministry staff, key leaders, and teams.
- Support the preparation and execution of online worship services.
- Manage assigned responsibilities within the limitations of the designated budget.
- Partner with and support other ministries and departments as needed, including but not limited to Care Nights, Student Ministries, and all-church initiatives.
- Contribute to the planning and execution of weekend services and special events through collaboration with the Arts Team.
- Attend weekly brainstorming, planning, and production meetings relevant to worship services and events.
- Schedule volunteers and contractors for weekend services using Planning Center.
- Communicate clearly and in a timely manner with ministry staff, key leaders, and teams.
- Support the preparation and execution of online worship services.
- Manage assigned responsibilities within the limitations of the designated budget.

Experience & Skills

- Ability to lead worship from an instrument (guitar preferred).
- Strong musical literacy, including the ability to read music and proficiency with the Nashville Number System.
- Proficient with Ableton Live.
- Ability to teach vocal harmony.
- Strong, top-tier vocal ability.

- Effective communicator with the ability to speak publicly and offer clear, Scripture-rooted devotional leadership.
- Skilled problem solver with sound judgment and adaptability.
- 3–5 years of experience leading worship in a church of comparable size or complexity (1,000+ average attendance preferred).
- Experience leading worship teams comprised of both volunteers and staff.

Additional Requirements

- Pastors are called upon to provide spiritual care and shepherding to members of the church family and the communities we serve, as needed.
- Pastors may be asked to officiate pastoral functions including weddings, funerals, baptisms, communion, and other ordinances or services of the church.
- Regular attendance at weekly Campus and/or ministry staff meetings.
- Attendance at monthly All-Staff meetings.
- Affirmation of The Compass Church Statement of Faith and theological alignment with The Compass Church and the Evangelical Free Church of America.
- Regular attendance at The Compass Church weekend worship services.
- Membership at The Compass Church within 12 months of employment (spouse included, if married).
- Maintain a working knowledge of Microsoft Office, Rock RMS, and Planning Center.
- Demonstrate flexibility and a willingness to perform other duties as assigned.
- This position requires flexibility, including evenings, weekends, and increased hours during major ministry seasons such as Easter and Christmas.

Campus Impact & Growth Expectations

The Wheaton Campus includes a 750-seat Worship Center and the capacity to serve up to approximately 1,500 people per weekend through multiple services. The Worship Pastor plays a vital role in stewarding this opportunity by leading worship experiences that are compelling, excellent, and spiritually formative. Through strong leadership, musical excellence, and team development, this role significantly contributes to worship attendance, campus growth, and the overall effectiveness of the Wheaton Campus in *Helping People Find & Follow God*.
