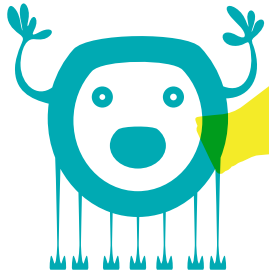

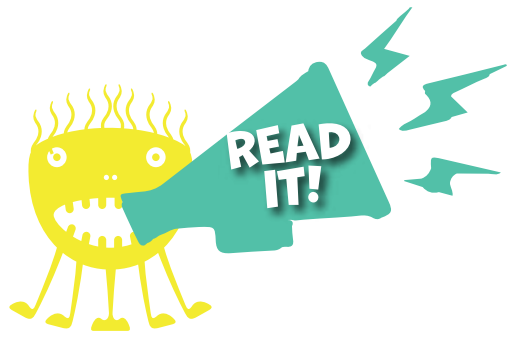
THIS WEEK WE LEARNED
