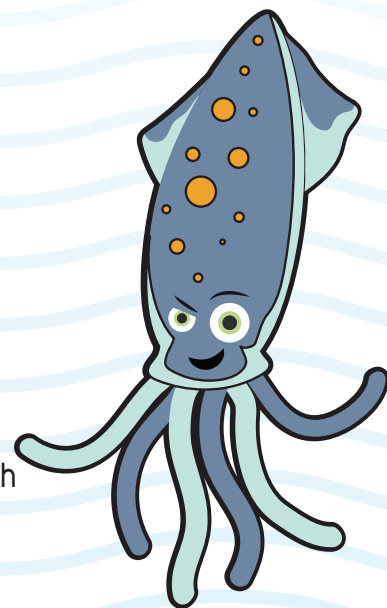
## This week we learned
