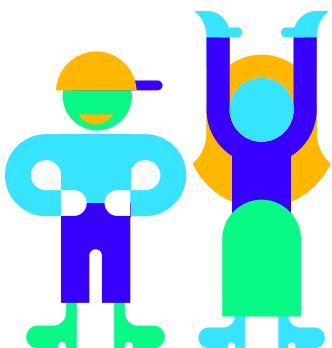
READ IT!
