**BIG IDEA:** God hears our prayers, so we can call out to Him with our whole heart.

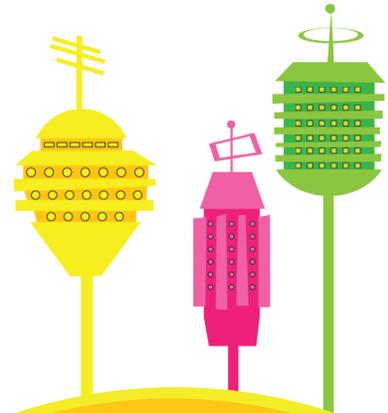
**BIBLE BASIS:** 1 Samuel 7
